For solar power, electricity and factory related applications which require a total wireless and Ethernet communication solutions, Advantech has released the ECU-1251 RISC-based industrial communication gateway. ECU-1251 has an open platform design with Cortex A8 processor, up to four RS-232/485 isolated serial ports, two 10/100 Ethernet ports and operating temperature range of -40~70°C.WithLinux operating system and open TagLink SDK, which enable to system integrators to develop applications which precisely fit their need.




Figure 1.1 ECU-1251 Chassis Dimensions




Figure 2.1 ECU-1251 overview





Figure 2.2 ECU-1251 LED status indicator

3.1 Wiring

3.1.1 Power Supply Wiring

ECU-1251 supports power input ranging from and 10VDC to 30V_{DC}.

- 1. Remove all power and signal connections.
- 2. Place the unit heat-sink side down.
- 3. Remove the screws shown below.




Figure 3.1 Power Supply Wiring




Figure 3.2 RS-232/485 Serial Ports (COM1~ COM4)

Figure 3.3 USB Connector







Figure 3.6 Jumper on the back motherboard

3.3 Installation

3.3.1 Wall-mounted and DIN-Rail Installation

ECU-1251 supports two types of installation: Wall-mounted and DIN-Rail Installation. For wall-mounted installation, users can fix the device on the wall with 4 screws as shown below.




Figure 3.7 Wall-mounted installation




Figure 3.8 Vertical DIN-Rail buckle Installation




Figure 3.9 Vertical DIN-Rail Installation

ECU-1251 is equipped with a Micro SD slot and a SIM slot.





Figure 3.10 SD&SIM Card Installation




Figure 3.11 Installing a Wireless module Card and Antenna
