Only 25.5 W input is assured to be available at the powered. The equipment is only to be connected to PoE networks without routing to outside plants.

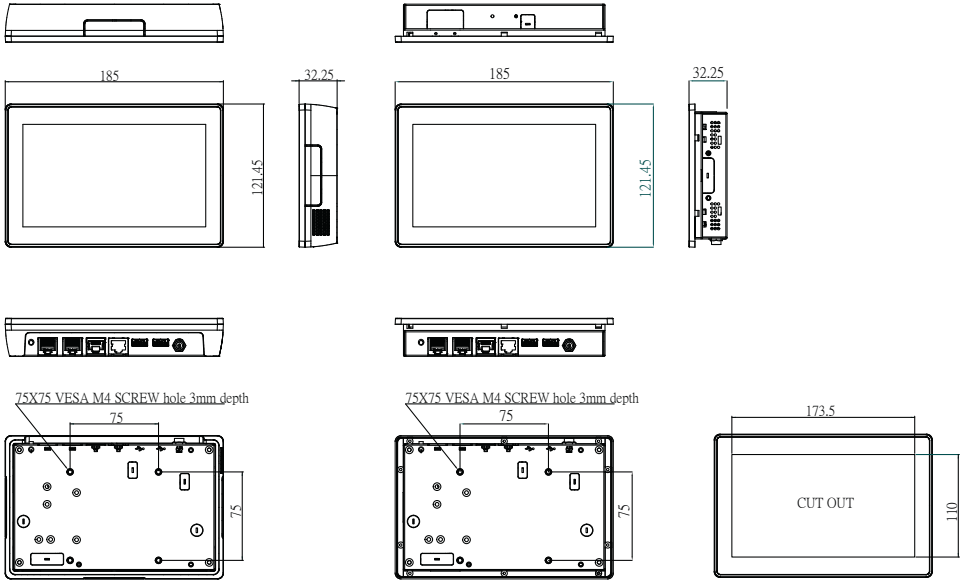

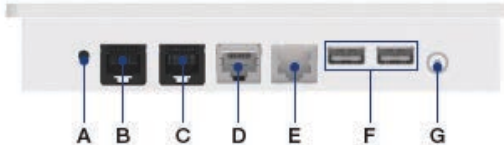

The customer can change the configuration only when total power input is under 25.5 W.

Safety Instructions
